The worst Post WWII damage to hit Japan

Japan's Nuclear Power Plant has reached a danger Lvl of 5. They have had a few explosion and those who have been exposed have been sent to direct care. The plant holds uranium and plutonium- yet many are working and risking their lives to stabilize it.

A Christian man named Naoyoshi Satou (now-yoh-shee sah-toe) is working to connect electric pipes to cool down the reactors. For his safety and success in stabilizing the plant, prayer is need. The rest of Japan is depending on those working at the plant. He is risking his life to save the lives of many others for generations to come. There are also five other Japanese Christians who are working at the plant as well. Please those working at the plant in your prayers.

In the Miyagi prefecture, one town Onagawa, half of its 10,000 population are dead or missing (LA NEWS)

On 19th, a 20 year old man was saved from underneath rubble where he had been trapped for 8 days. Many have gone missing, and they have not even been able to find the bodies. The bodies that have been washing up on shores, along with cars and rubble, were killed instantly. A few have managed to stay a live while grabbing on to debris for several days, but not many have been so lucky.

The rest of Japan:

They are conducting scheduled 4-6 hour daily blackouts to send power up north. Japan runs mainly on electrical power more than the US, so the Japanese people are experiencing extremities that which of they are not use to. Not only power, but water as well-many have not been able to take showers for days, make food, or keep in contact with loved ones during this time.

His Call Church is currently attempting to send needed goods for survival to Fukushima of those who are working at the Plant. As well as Currently arranging to send off goods to North East Central Church (Gospel Town) in Sendai, Miyagi Prefecture Japan. This is the area that has received the most damage. They are asking the church to distribute those goods appropriately. His call is also working with other Local Churches, such as Tokyo Jesus Life House, Life Church in Osaka Japan and many others to reach out those up north.
